ABOUT ARTSPACE

Founded in 1974, Artspace was one of the first artist-run centres in Canada and remains a vital hub for artists today. The centre has been serving Peterborough and surrounding communities while attracting respected talent from across the country for **50 years**.

Artspace is a charitable, non-profit, artist-run centre that assists artists with the presentation of new work and acts as a regional centre for professional development in the arts community. Our exhibitions and public programming foster a stronger appreciation for Canadian contemporary art and serve as a knowledge-building and community-building platform for artists and art appreciators alike.

Our programming is national in scope and regional in spirit. We strive to present thought-provoking exhibitions that engage with diverse perspectives through collaboration with artists at all career stages, and working in any medium. OUR MAKER SPACE

In early 2023, Artspace expanded its existing Media Lab into a much more substantial Maker Space, making new tools and studio space available at a low cost. The new studio setup includes resources for printmaking, bookbinding, zine printing, vinyl cutting, hand and machine sewing, drawing and painting with a variety of materials, and of course a larger and more accessible studio space, furniture, and task lighting.


As always, our objective is to teach people how to use the tools and equipment in the Maker Space for free.
